How to Take Part

2. Observe all the wildlife that lives near you. Take time to really look and listen for birds, insects and more. Spending even ten minutes outside this way will reveal a lot
3. **Snap a photo, or make a sketch.** Document what you find in some way
4. **Share it** There are three ways you can share:
 5. On social media, through your teacher or with permission at #backyardbio
 6. On the INaturalist app as a classroom, connecting with other naturalists worldwide. You can also use the Seek App to ID what you're looking at
